

UNIFORM

<u>Standard uniform</u>	BOYS	GIRLS
Blazer	Navy blue with school badge.	
Shirt	White.	
Pullover	Fine knit – navy blue with v-neck collar (this is optional)	
Trousers	Standard black school trousers (denim, canvas and leggings are not permitted)	
Shoes	Sensible black plain leather shoes. Trainers of any kind / Dr Marten style boots are not permitted. As we are preparing students for life after school, our policy on shoes is very straightforward; the easiest way of interpreting the policy is if the shoes are suitable to wear for a formal interview, they are suitable for school.	
Ties	Navy blue with a stripe in the relevant House colour.	
Skirt		Sensible navy skirt (worn to knee length). Short or mini-skirts are not permitted.

<u>PE Uniform</u>	All clothing must be purchased from school kit providers and must have the Little Lever School logo on it, except for trainers and moulded boots.

	Teal and navy reversible shirt (outdoor). Tracksuit bottoms not allowed.	Teal and navy hoodie (outdoor). Optional matching tracksuit pants in winter.

Bags / Equipment:

- An appropriate school bag
- Planner, pen, pencil, ruler, rubber & pencil sharpener
- **An appropriate reading book should be brought to school EVERY day**
- PE kit for the relevant days.

Additional guidance:

- Only a watch is permitted. Any other jewellery will be confiscated until the end of the school day.
- **As of September, we will be supporting the 'Phone-free school' campaign, joining thousands of schools nationally. If a student is to have their phone on them, it must be switched off and in their bag when on site.**
- Unusual hair colours and extreme hairstyles including cut patterns/lines are not permitted
- Students' names should be marked clearly on all items of clothing
- Make-up, false eyelashes, nail varnish, false nails and tattoos are not permitted in school.

Students who do not arrive at school in correct uniform will be offered spare uniform by the school. If students choose not to wear the appropriate uniform and/or refuse to follow a reasonable request, such as borrowing uniform, then we will issue a consequence in line with our behaviour policy and expectations. Students will not be allowed in mainstream lessons until the situation is resolved. Jewellery will be confiscated until the end of the day and placed in the office for students to collect. If this becomes persistent, additional consequences will apply.
