HIGH SCHOOL VACCINATIONS: Information for parents



What vaccinations should I expect my child to receive this term?

From April 2024 to July 2024, the Immunisation Team will be continuing to offer and deliver the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccinations to all pupils in Year 8

HPV - What do I need to do?



You now should have received a consent pack through school or in the post.

Please return this consent form to school, even if you do not wish for your child to receive these vaccinations, so we can update your child's records.

Measles. Mumps and Rubella (MMR) **Vaccinations**

The Immunisation Team will also be offering the MMR Vaccination to any young person in Years 7 - 13 who may be incomplete with these vaccinations.

What do I need to do?

Please check your child's red book (this was given at birth) or contact your GP Practice if you are unsure about your child's MMR Status

If your child is outstanding with an MMR, please contact the Immunisation Team via the contact details below and we will advise how these vaccinations can be completed

Year 11 Pupils

If your child is in Year 11, you may have received a letter from us regarding their Immunisation Status and any outstanding vaccinations they may still require before leaving school at the end of August 2024.
